Competition Terms and Conditions

- The Promoter of the “Student Digital Experience Tracker 2018” is the Murdoch University Library within Murdoch University of South Street, Murdoch.
- These Standard Competition Terms and Conditions form the Terms and Conditions.
- The Competition begins on 1st March 2018. To be eligible to enter the Competition a Student Digital Experience Tracker 2018 entry must be completed and submitted online between 9am (AWST) on Thursday 1st March and 11:59pm (AWST) on Saturday 31st March 2018. Entries received after this time will not be included in the Competition and Murdoch University Library accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected Entries.
- Entrance into the Competition is limited to one entry per person.
- Entrance into the Competition is open to current Murdoch University Students based in Western Australia.
- Entrants go into the draw to win a Google Home Mini.
- Winners will be selected by a random draw of eligible Entrants.
- All Prize Winners will be notified by their nominated email address supplied on the survey form submitted within 30 days of the Competition’s closure. The Promoter will use reasonable efforts to notify the Winner, using the nominated email address. If the contact details are recorded incorrectly, the Promoter does not accept responsibility for the inability to make contact with a Winner and another Winner will be selected and notified as set out in these Terms and Conditions.
- Acceptance of a Prize constitutes permission for Murdoch University Library to use the Winner’s name and photo for advertising, marketing and promotional purposes without compensation to the Prize winner, unless otherwise prohibited by law.
